## NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR BRAILLE AND TACTILE SIGNAGE FOR THE VISION IMPAIRED.

It is now compulsory for facilities catering for the disabled to have Braille and Tactile signage for the vision impaired. All new Exeloo units comply with the new requirements and the signs are available for retrofit as well.

## EXELOO ARRIVES IN DARWIN

Darwin took delivery of its first Exeloo for North Cliff. It is our second installation in the Northern Territory. The unit was shipped from the factory in Auckland to Adelaide and was then transported by truck to Darwin. It was the longest overland transport to site of an Exeloo unit.

**Darwin City Council** has chosen Exeloo to provide their constituents with a safe and hygienic public toilet and high degree of vandal resistance. Additionally to other parts of Australia, the Exeloo unit had to comply with the Northern Territories stringent cyclone ratings.

## EXELOOS ARE BECOMING A COMMON FEATURE AT THE GOLD COAST

**Gold Coast City Council** have purchased 3 more Exeloo units, making it so far a total of 6 installations.



Two twin units (Model 07) are being installed on the beach front at the high profile tourist area of **Surfers Paradise Beach** to provide tourist and locals with a safe and hygienic toilet facility. They replaced a public toilet facility, which no longer reflected the high profile of this internationally famous tourist destination.

**Cooloongatta** is to gain its first Exeloo installation because of Gold Coast City Council's ongoing commitment to provide the public with safe and hygienic toilet facilities. The Exeloo will become an integral part of Gold Coast City Council's new shelter and car park manager's office complex.

## GALAXY EXELOO AVAILABLE AS TWIN TOILET

The first "Twin" Galaxy has been installed in **St. Kilda, Melbourne**. It features one single user cubicle complying with AS 1428.1-2001 for disabled access and



one single user cubicle with a 800 mm door opening suitable for the ambulant disabled. The Galaxy Exeloo replaced a 1970 bluestone toilet block, which became a

"dangerous" place according to local police because of robberies, stabbings, prostitution and drug dealing. The president of the local Trading Association stated that the area is now safer and more appealing for visitors. "We'll get that cosmopolitan feeling back to the street; we've lost that in the last couple of years" he said.

## TWEED SHIRE COUNCIL

**Tweed Shire Council** has joined the growing number of Exeloo customers in NSW with the order of a fully automated unit for their park at Chinderah. Council chose Exeloo to assist with a variety of social and operational issues. A second unit is now in planning for Mooball and

will incorporate a Bendigo style roof to blend in with the architectural theme of the area.

## JONDARYAN SHIRE COUNCIL

**Jondaryan Shire Council** purchased their second Exeloo for Trousdell Park, Cotswold Hills. The unit will provide a much needed amenity in this relatively new area located on the outskirts of the Toowoomba urban spread. This Exeloo unit compliments the existing amenities and sporting facilities.



## ORANGE CITY COUNCIL

**Orange City Council** took delivery of its second Exeloo unit after the very successful installation of their first



Exeloo at the Woolworth's car park 16 months ago. The unit has been installed at the Adventure Playground adjacent to the Orange Botanical Gardens.

## FIRST EXELOO FOR CENTRAL QUEENSLAND

**Livingston Shire Council** has included a manually operated Exeloo in their new bus interchange development at Yeppoon. Exeloo manufactured the unit in colours selected to match those used in the total development. An automatic door option as featured in the fully automated Exeloo was included to assist users with disabilities.
