EXELOO ARRIVES AT THE TOP END

Nhulunbuy Corporation in the Northern Territory is taking delivery of their first Exeloo unit later this month. Nhulunbuy is a remote community on the Gove Peninsula. This installation will be the most remote in Australia and the first in the Northern Territory as well. It will also be one of the longest journeys of an Exeloo unit to site. The unit will be transported by truck and barge to site in Nhulunbuy from Port Brisbane.

The Exeloo III has been chosen to compliment the town's comprehensive and modern facilities. Key decisions were Exeloo's superior resistance to vandalism and the self-cleaning cycle to maintain a clean and a hygienic amenity in a tropical climate as well as the proven reliability of Exeloo being essential for such a remote location.

2 NEW EXELOO INSTALLATIONS FOR WOLLONGONG CITY COUNCIL

Wollongong City Council took delivery of further 2 Exeloo units for Parks in **Figtree** and **Unanderra** bringing it to a total of 8 Exeloo units operating in the Wollongong area. The latest units delivered feature a concrete roof, a stainless steel facade, smoke and fire detectors and a sprinkler system to combat arson by vandals.
